

**"Artist mobility and residency programmes: opportunities and challenges"**

28th and 29<sup>th</sup> of November 2013

The event had three objectives:

The first was to offer to artists, curators and creators useful information to orient themselves within the wide range of existing opportunities on artist mobility and residency programmes. The talks along with the portfolio workshop provided them with practical tools that will help them in the future to find and choose the mobility or residency programme that best meets their needs and interests.

The second objective of the event was to reflect on how residencies can contribute to current contemporary art scene. To do this, we organised a round table with the participation of Trans Artists Desk/DutchCulture, Res Artis, Art Motile, On-the-move and Interarts, among others.

Finally, a workshop led by Julie's Bicycle addressed a pending issue in our agendas: the environmental impact of artist mobility. During the workshop we explored the relationship between mobility and residency programmes and their environmental impact, presenting solutions to make them more sustainable.
